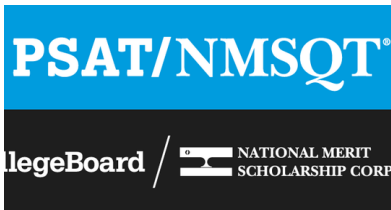


Student Council Meeting
