- 1. Directly to the school for tuition, books, fees, and supplies.
- 2. Directly to the student upon proof of payment for qualifying expenses.
- 3. The award must be used within one year of receiving the award.
- 4. Payment will be made by the Sterling/Rock Falls Community Trust.

INSTRUCTIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Minimum accumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- 2. Completed application by applicant.
 - a. Please type or print clearly.
 - b. College and High School students can use the same application form.
 - c. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- 3. Current *official school transcript* of courses completed. (*Not* an internet version)
- 4. Two current, dated, and preferably typewritten reference letters.
 - a. From non-family members.
 - b. They should be included with the application
 - i. Letters can be sent in sealed envelopes, if desired by the author.
 - ii. This instruction page can be shared with the people providing letters.
 - iii. We prefer they are **NOT** mailed direct to the Optimist Club.
- 5. Current typewritten biographical essay about yourself including goals, special needs, future plans, work experiences, and any other information that you wish to share.
- 6. In order, staple the application, transcripts, references, and essay with <u>one</u> staple.
