As we all know, the Covid-19 pandemic is responsible for changing a lot of plans for our 2019-2020 School Year. We began Remote Learning at Newman on March 16th, 2020. Our Senior Class rallied together and participated in some pretty cool socially-distanced projects. Some of them painted their parking places in the back lot at the school, the Junior Class delivered prom flowers to the upperclassmen, and Class of 2020 signs were placed in the Senior Stu-

dents' yards. Baccalaureate was held virtually on May 18th, 2020 but the senior class overwhelmingly chose to have an in-person graduation. The date for the Graduation was July 20th, 2020, and was held at St. Andrew Catholic Church in Rock Falls. It was small, only 2 adults per student were allowed. The Mass was led by Fr. Richard Kramer and Fr. Bruce Ludeke. The event was streamed on our NFHS service. Not every graduate could make it but they were acknowl-



edged in prayer and their diplomas were placed in their reserved seats. It was an amazing way for the Class of 2020 to have some sort of closure on their senior year of high school.


Dear Alumni, Family and Friends of Newman Central Catholic High School:

2020 has been a year that will be one for the history books! We have experienced a year like no other- from the pandemic, to the derecho, to the record breaking hurricanes and the presidential election. All of these have taught us something...God is in control.

Schools have been faced with the challenge of opening up and determining what is the best and safest way to have in-person learning. Newman was no different in this aspect. The School Improvement Team spent the summer developing a Reopening Plan with the goal always being in-person learning 5 days a week. A plan was developed and the school year began on schedule. Newman students have been in-person learning since the start of the school year. Although we have had individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 and individuals who have had to be quarantined, these events have not affected the learning environment. The staff and students have worked hard to follow protocols so that we can continue in-person learning. We are blessed to have such dedicated teachers and staff.

Due to the pandemic, there have been hardships placed on families, schools and businesses. Fundraising activities are going to look differently as they will become virtual fundraisers. This past September Newman hosted our Annual Golf Outing which raises money for the tuition assistance program at Newman. The team of Jim Olson, Mike Sprague, Tim Nelson and Dr. David Yeager put in a lot of time and energy into making sure the Golf Outing was a success. I am proud to announce that they raised \$56,609 for the Tuition Assistance Program and an additional \$17,000 towards scholarships. Thank you to the team for their dedication and efforts. For the 2020-2021 school year, we have 24 students who qualified for tuition assistance and received a total of \$37,125. Newman also had 105 students who applied for scholarships and were awarded a total of \$124,475. This need continues to grow.




During this time of our Annual Appeal we hope that you, our families, friends and alumni, will continue to support our efforts with your prayerful contribution.
