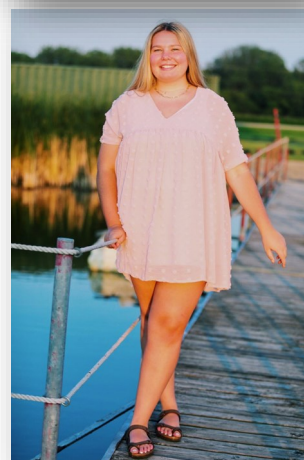

This year Newman Central Catholic High School Theology department went on two spiritual Kairos Retreats at Bishop Lane in Rockford, Illinois. Our future graduating seniors went in December and then 14 young men and women turned around and lead the junior class in the second week of March. Eucharistic Adoration has been tremendously meaningful for both classes. A moment of clarity and unity is shared with their classmates, as well as a realization that it is Christ that brings them together.

Our Freshman went on retreat to LOMC where we shared some outdoor team building experiences. The class was able to spend a day getting to know each other a little better and finding ways to support each other in their upcoming high school experiences.

Our Sophomore retreat entailed a community service project in conjunction with a guest speaker on Theology of the Body. Our Sophomores went to the feeder schools and helped beautify and interact with the students in different projects and activities. In the spring, the Sophomores went to Libertyville to experience their faith outside of the school at St. Maximillian Kolbe Shrine. Here they watched a video of St. Kolbe and his life and then went and toured a replica of the cell where he was imprisoned and pictures of his imprisonment in Auschwitz. Sophomores also visited Greencastle assisted living facility in Sterling. There the students assisted residents with technology, played games, interviewed residents and helped with some daily chores.

We wrapped up the year with another day retreat for the seniors (to make up for their cancelled retreat last year.) The day was filled with Mass, games, skits, prayer, and bonding. The students were able to revisit their Kairos pods for sharing and reflection and culminate the day in treasured Eucharistic Adoration. To wrap it up, we celebrated with a piñata!

The students of all four classes signed and presented thank you posters to all the faculty and staff for Catholic Schools Weeks Teacher/Staff Appreciation Day. The kids were excited to do this for all staff members and the posters were well received.

As usual the theology department decorated for the holiday season of Christmas, Lent, and this year we expanded Lent to a Divine Mercy presentation with Easter Lilies and a Divine Mercy Portrait.

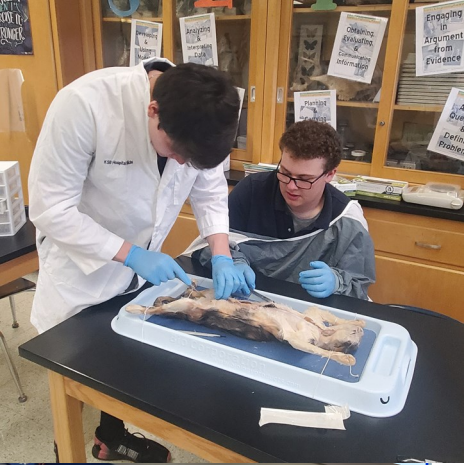

team advanced Kyle Wolfe and Jacob Donald to the state meet in Bloomington with Kyle placing 9th. The volleyball team played for a regional championship after getting to 25 regular season wins.

The Winter saw our wrestling team advance to dual team sectionals while sending 4 individuals to state - Will Rude, Carter Rude, Briar Ivey, and Brady Grennan. Our music department sent 6 kids to solo and ensemble contest and they collectively brought back 10 division 1 superior ratings and 21 medals. The math team placed first in their state qualifier and advanced to state. The individual medalists were plentiful. The boys basketball team won the regional and advanced to a sectional championship game. Coach Sharp picked up his 300th win this season. The girls basketball team battled night in and night out and improved in many areas of the game. The cheer squad was there all Fall and Spring to bring the energy and crowd participation that we all love. The scholastic bowl team finished up their conference season and gains were made in many areas.

This Spring brought many struggles with the weather but our teams battled through it. The tennis team finished the season with a winning record. The track and field team sent 8 men and 1 woman to the state meet in Charles-

ton. The 4x800 team brought home state hardware. Our choir and band both graced us with excellent performances in their concerts in the Spring and Winter. Our bass fishing team had a good day of fishing at the Spring Lake Campground and caught almost 7.5 pounds of bass. The softball team won a regional championship and played in the sectional. The baseball team won a regional and sectional championship and played in their second consecutive Elite 8 game.

We have much to be thankful for at Newman. The success that our kids have is a testament to the hard work of our kids, coaches, teachers, and families. More important than all of our success in competition, however, is the life skills and values that our kids learn. 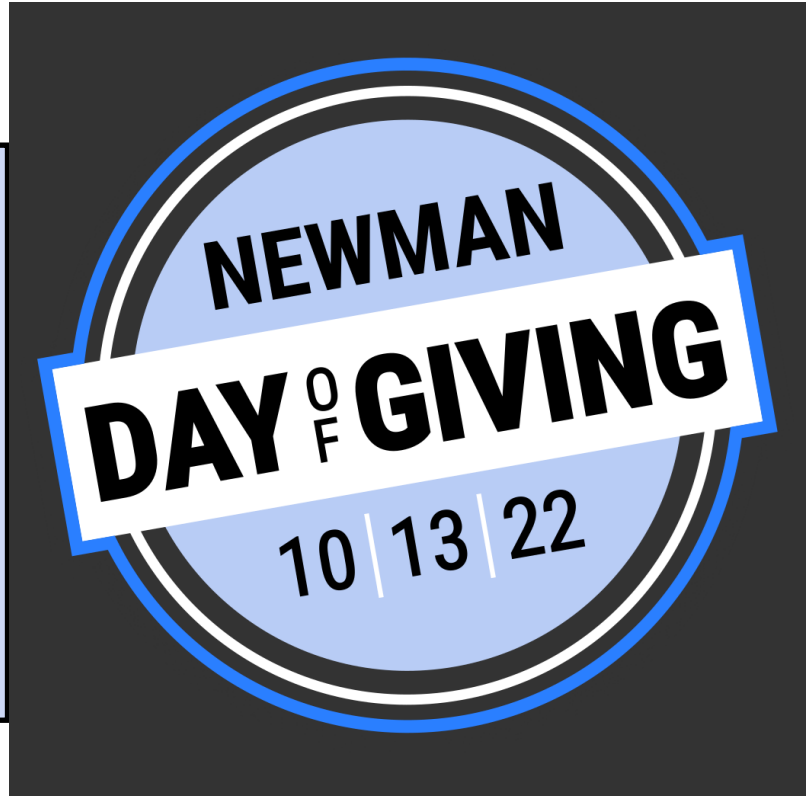
tion from the University of Nebraska. Andy and wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Christopher, who is a class of 2024 Newman Comet and
