Success through Adversity

The Student Body has overcome some pretty adverse



obstacles. They took the 4th quarter of the 2019-2020 school year remotely, with only a days notice, due to the worldwide pandemic. Thanks to the School Improvement Committee and their attention to detail along with the extra work put in by Mr. Wood and his staff, the entire student body was able to return to school full time in August of 2020. There were some distinct differences; Temperature checks and forms to submit, wearing masks all day, every-day. One way traffic in the hallways, assigned and socially distanced seating, classes taking place in the cafeteria and practice facility to ensure social distancing, adjustments to Mass days where half of the students watched remotely from the school., 1/4

of the students viewed the feed from the church basement and 1/4 were seated in the church. It must also be recognized that all sports were put "on hold." This left a hole in the lives of many of our students and families.

Through all of the challenges, our Newman family persevered! Our teachers quickly adapted to remote learning and digital classrooms, our kitchen and maintenance staffs adjusted their workload and processes to meet the ISBE and IDPH guidelines. Mr. Nelson spent many hours lining up and assisting the NFHS broadcasts of Mass and events throughout the year. Most of all, our students handled themselves like true champions. Our parents and guardians were supportive of our staff and their many acts of kindness were greatly appreciated.

As the school year moved along, it was evident that our student athletes were really missing their sports. Tennis, golf and cross

country were able to compete in the Fall but other Fall and Winter sports and activities were delayed more than once. The coaches and Mrs. Passini held it all together and worked tirelessly on schedules and accommodations to get our athletes back to sports. As it turned out, every sport was able to have an abbreviated season with modifications on mask-wearing and spectators at each of the different events.

We were very excited to be able to have traditional Baccalaureate and Graduation ceremonies with the Most Reverend Bishop David J. Malloy and Michael Kagan, Superintendent of Rockford Diocese Schools and Director of Religious Education joining us.




our Newman Fund and Identity Committees.

Sports and activities looked a lot different this year in the state of Illinois. The Fall started with Girls Tennis, Golf and Cross Country being able to have abbreviated seasons with no IHSA state competitions. Kyle Wolfe '23 and Blake Wolfe '21 would have qualified to play at State had there been a competition.

After many delays, Volleyball and Basketball were able to play and Scholastic Bowl started their season. Again, no state competitions for these athletes.

Math Team participated virtually and yielded some great results. For the second year in a row, Math Team placed 1st in our region. Logan Devine '24, placed 3rd in Algebra I, Ainsley Reed '23, placed

1st in the Region in Geometry. Bella Trancoso, Nate Neubauer and Adrian Ackert, all Class of 2021, tied for Regional 1st place in pre-calc.

At last in the spring, we were able to root on the Football, Boys Tennis and Track teams!

By late spring and early summer, our baseball, softball and wrestlers were competing. There were some official IHSA state competitions this year but not every sport sponsored State contests. Lady Comets Softball were Regional Champs! The Boys baseball team won sectionals making Newman Baseball history! Boys track relay team of Thomas Powers '22, Noah Welty '21, Jacob Donald '22, and Lucas Simpson '24 ran the 4X8 at state. Marvel Zhang made it to the state tennis tournament. Three of

our wrestlers competed at the IWCOA (Illinois Wrestling Coaches and Officials Association) State Tournament. Will Rude '22, won the championship in the 138 weight class, Brady Grennan '24 placed third in 113 and Carter Rude '24 wrestled at state in the 120 weight class. Congratulations to all of our athletes and coaches on successful seasons.




Classroom Activities




