

Lee County Democrats 2025 Scholarship

The Lee County Democratic Central Committee (LCDCC) is pleased to announce that 2 \$500 scholarships will be awarded to 2 graduating high school seniors residing in Lee County in the Spring of 2025. The Lee County Democrats strongly support education and job training for Lee County students, and are hopeful that this scholarship will bring the recipient one step closer to achieving their goals. The qualifications and guidelines for the scholarship are listed on page 2.

Qualifications and Guidelines

- Qualifications: Applicants must be a high school senior who resides in Lee County. Applicants may attend high school outside of Lee County but they must reside at a Lee County address to be eligible for the scholarship.
- Secondary Education Institutions: Students who will be attending a 4 year University/College, Community College, Trade School, or Apprenticeship Program are eligible for the scholarship.
- **Essay:** In addition to filling out a short application, students must submit an essay of up to 300 words that discusses their time in high school, their long term goals, and how a LCDCC scholarship can help them achieve those goals.
- Essay, Transcript, and Application Submission: The deadline for consideration is April 1, 2025. Students may email their applications, transcripts, and essays to demsofleecountyil@gmail.com. If students prefer to submit their applications via the U.S. Postal Service, they can mail their essay and application to the address listed below no later than April 1, 2025.


