His writings of his time in prison show how close his friendship with God had become, and he is honored today as one of the revered doctors of the Church. The silence of his prison cell gave him time to grow in his relationship with God, so perhaps in these busy days, it would be good to find some silent time to enable us to also grow in our relationship with God.
